FIELD SESSION DIRECTIONS



Albie Barden, Maine Wood Heat Co., Norridgewock, Maine

From the South or North on I-95: Take exit 132 and take Route 139 North to Norridgewock. At the stop sign in downtown Norridgewock go straight through the center of town. At the stoplight, take a right onto Rt 201A North towards Madison. After 3.6 miles Father Rasle Road will be on your left. Take the Father Rasle Road and follow for one mile. After you cross the railroad tracks, it is the second house on the left- a red house and several barns. Please use the furthest driveway and park at that end.

Grand Central Café, Waterville, Maine

Grand Central Cafe is located in Railroad Square between College Ave. and Main Street in Waterville, Maine. From Interstate 95, get off at Main Street, exit 130 (formerly 34) and head towards downtown Waterville. About a mile from the exit, look for a large, yellow sign on your left as you cross the railroad tracks. Our entrance is between the RR tracks and the Burger King sign. As you pull in the parking lot, Grand Central Café will be in the building to your right, all the way at the end furthest from Main Street.

Dusty Dowse, Cambridge, Maine

From Rt 95 coming North: Get off at Newport (about 25 minutes north of Waterville) and turn left at end of ramp. Go straight through lights and north on rt 7 until Dexter, about 20 minutes. In Dexter, go straight through the light (But wait till it is green;-)) and in one block, go left onto 23 NORTH. You'll cross a bridge between two halves of the lake, then pass Shore Rd on left. Turn right on the NEXT left - Cambridge road. We are about 5-6 miles out on the right. You'll be going down a long hill and see the red roof of our barn about 2 miles ahead, just after you cross a small river.

From Skowhegan: take 150 north for about a half hour or so to Cambridge Village, which is recognizable because there is a little lake on the left. You'll make a sharp left as you come into town, and just past the general store, our road is on the right - Dexter Rd. Com out about 5 miles. The road is very straight until just before our house. You'll see 2 dirt roads leaving on the left, come around a curve, and we are on the left. Big barn with red roof, and oven visible in the yard.

Jim & Lisa Veilleux, Oaks Pond, Skowhegan, Maine

From Skowhegan: Exiting Tewksbury Hall, Take a LEFT onto Rt. 2 and continue on it for 6.7 miles. Take a RIGHT (look for balloons) onto Kingfisher Lane for 4/10th. mile, Take a LEFT onto Chickadee Lane and stop before the stream. The Veilleux's will be the last building on that road.
